Urgent Notice to IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations 46th Edition

Canadian State Variation CAG-20

CAG-20 reads: "The shipping document for dangerous goods transported by aircraft must be in the format established on the shipper's declaration specimen illustrated in Section 8.1.7 of the 42nd Edition of the "Dangerous Goods Regulations" published by the International Air Transport Association (IATA)." The Canadian Government has issued a Permit for Equivalent Level of Safety, Permit No. SA 8277 dated December 24, 2004 with an expiry date of January 31, 2007 that the format established on the Shipper's Declaration specimen illustrated in Section 8.1.7 of the 46th Edition of the "Dangerous Goods Regulations" published by the International Air Transport Association is authorized to be used.

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
